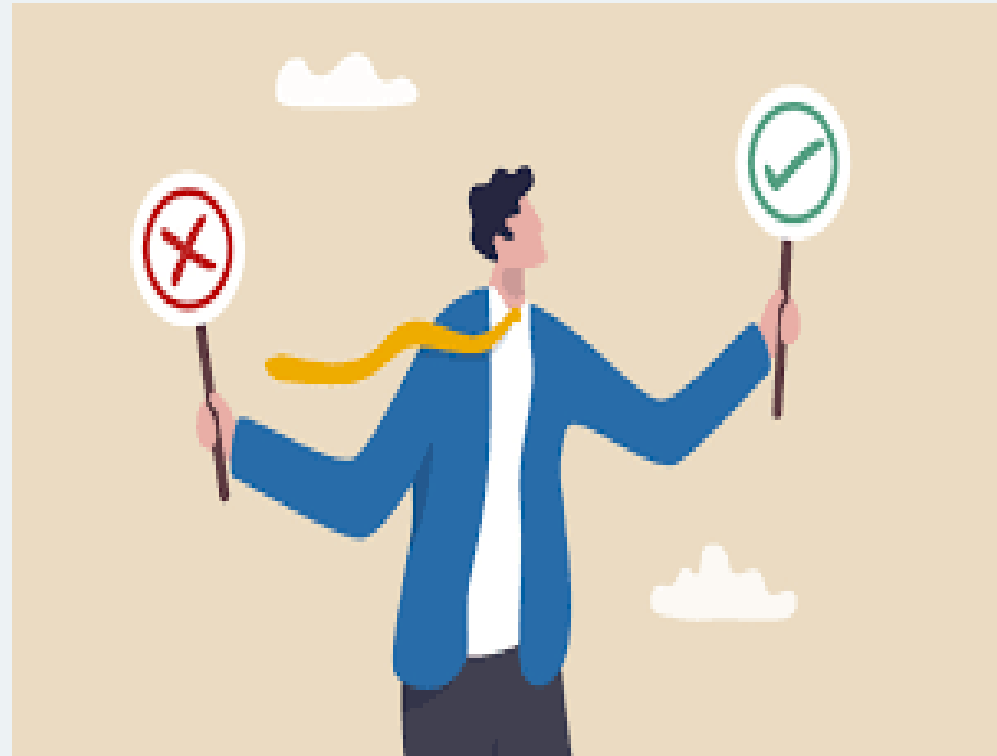


Right

Ethics

Judgement

is the court's decision, spelled out in a court order.



Verdict

a verdict is a decision made by a jury regarding the guilt or innocence of a defendant in a criminal case or the liability of a party in a civil case.
