


Cybercrime

crime committed over the Internet.





Cybercrime is defined as an unlawful action against any person using a **computer**, its **systems**, and its online or offline **applications**.

➔ It occurs when **information** technology is used to commit or cover an **offense**.

➔ *the act is only considered Cybercrime if it is intentional and not accidental.

Defamation



Publication by which other persons are likely to be induced to shun, avoid, ridicule or despise him

- ▶ the publication of a statement about a person that tends to lower his reputation.

Rehabilitation/ Restore the honor



- ➔ the action of restoring someone to former privileges or reputation after a period of disfavour.

- A tort is an act or omission that gives rise to injury or harm.
- a civil wrong for which courts impose liability.

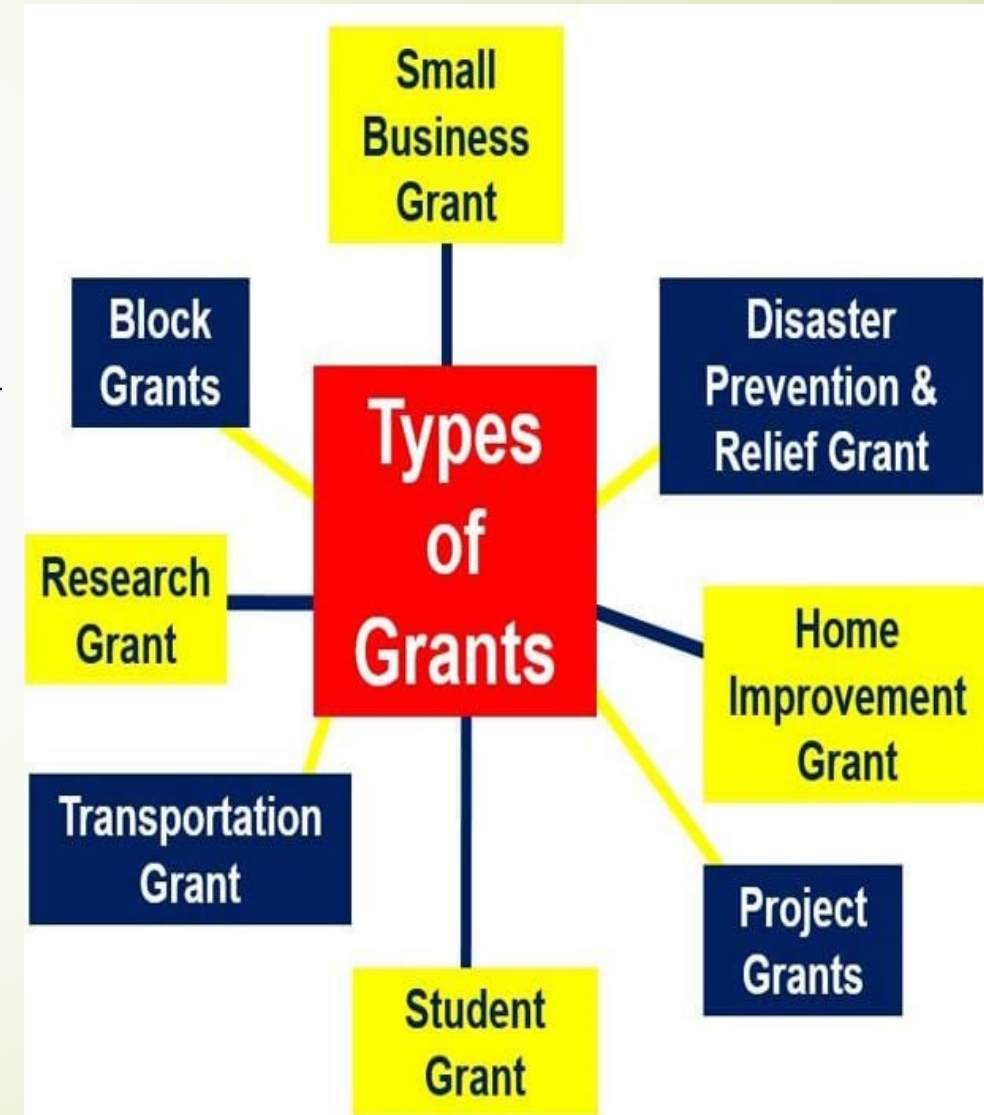
Corporation
